Paperwork Checklist

With the upcoming change of administration, it's a good idea to update name and/or gender marker on as much paperwork as you can, while you can. Here are some things to update:

- Birth Certificate
 - Naturalization Certificate, if you're a naturalized citizen
- Social Security Administration record
 - Your social security card won't show gender, but SSA keeps a record digitally
- DEERS record
 - Contact your personnel office
 - Also update: DD-214
- VA Healthcare
- Federal ID (Passport, CAC, Veteran ID)
- State ID (Driver's License, Real ID)


Now, things are looking bleak again. But we will continue to stand, as we have stood for years, to provide for the community and weather the storms on the horizon.

(Summarized Totality of Community Circumstances)

TITLE IX Withdrawn

As of Dec 20th the Department of Education (DoE) has withdrawn the proposal of Title IX protections for Transgender athletes from elementary to the NCAA level. If passed, would've more broadly protected gay and transgender students to participate in sports. Since 2020 there have been laws passed prohibiting transgender students from competing in sports. In total there are 25 states with state-laws that have outright banned transgender students to participate; 1 state with regulations to ban transgender students to participate in sports. However the SCOTUS have temporarily blocked laws from taking effect in AZ, UT, WV, and ID.



In the darker color are the states that has a ban.

In the lighter color are the states that don't have a ban at this time.

Symbology ()

The first meaning of the triangle is the Greek Delta: a symbol for change, an inherent part of the trans experience.

The second meaning of the triangle is a reference to the historic Pink Triangle: the first reclaimed symbol of the queer community, predating the rainbow flag.

The third meaning of the triangle: Each leg, being slightly different in shape and direction, represent the trans masc, trans femme, and nonbinary experiences. All are different paths in different directions, but form a cohesive community.

The stars - in no particular order - represent the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Space Force, Coast Guard, and Civilians (those affected by the ban, civilian allies, and family members).

Queer History

On 2010 January 4th, Amanda Simpson was appointed as the senior technical advisor in the Bureau of Industry and Security. This was the first time an openly trans person was appointed to a high level government position. She went on to serve in Pentagon at various important

positions until 2017. She continues to work for the LGBTQ+ community and in the field of aeronautics.
